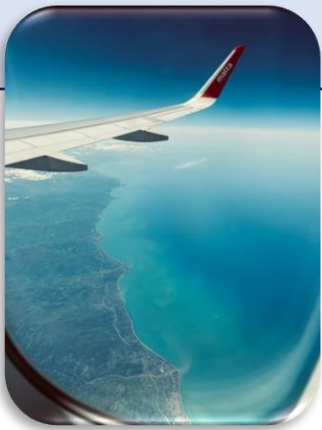


Malta travel blog

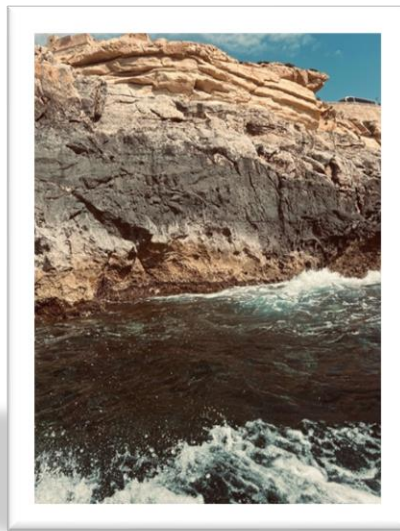
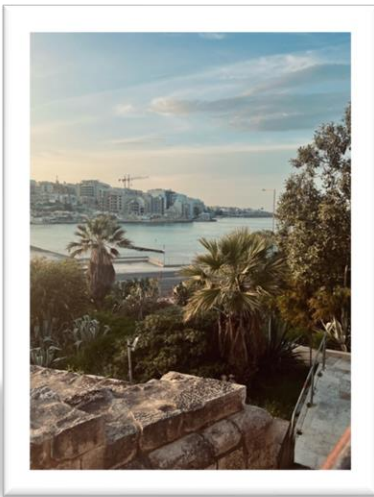
Where we stayed:
